8:00 AM: 5K presented by Jumer's Casino & Hotel & Interstate Batteries of the Quad Cities

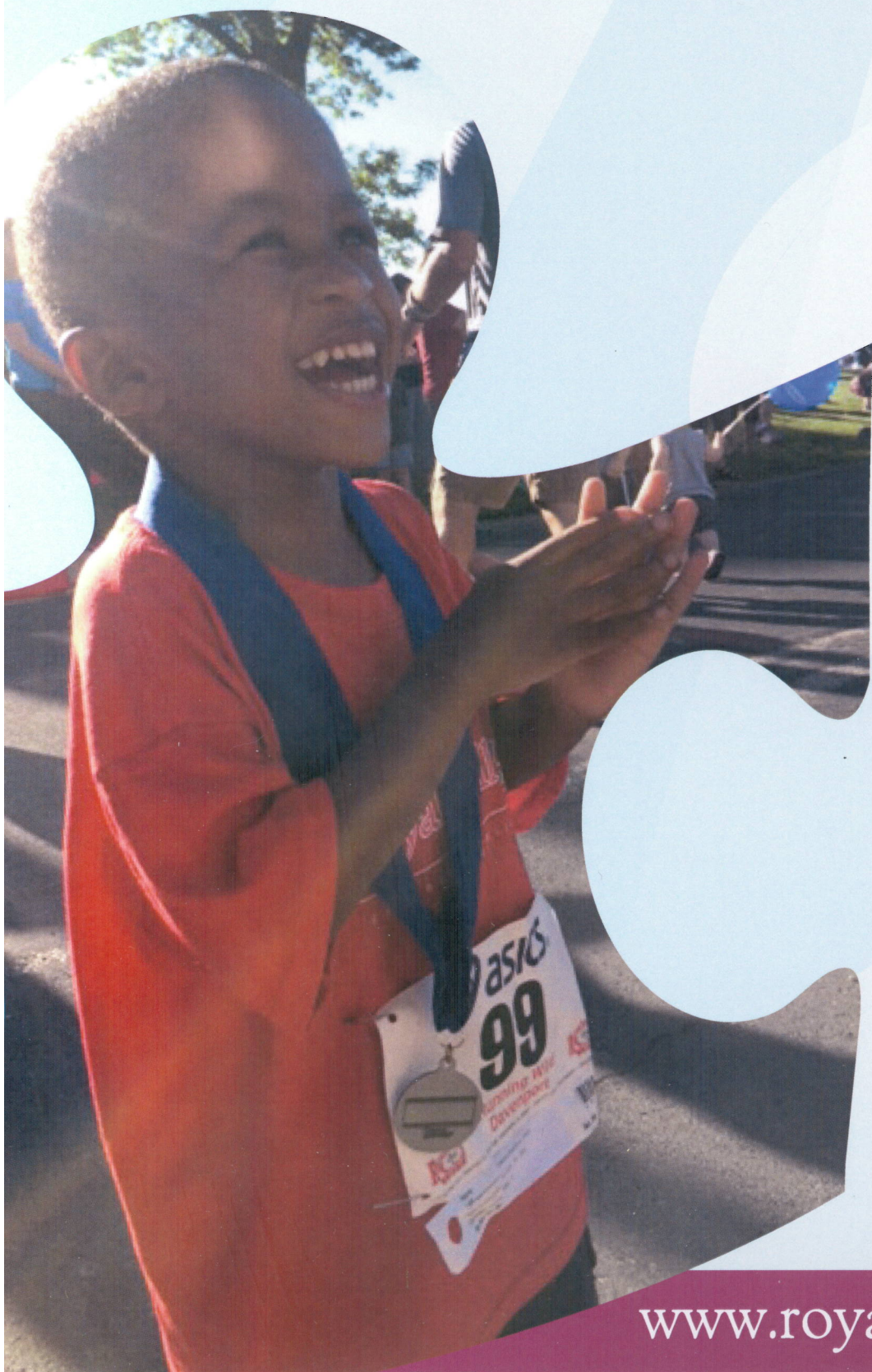
